Our goal is to provide students with the intellectual tool kit and practical skills necessary to be productive researchers in therapeutics discovery and development throughout the workforce.

TGP admissions is open to current G1, G2, and G3 students in any of the 13 Harvard Integrated Life Sciences (HILS) programs, as well as the Harvard-MIT Health Sciences and Technology (HST) program. Applicants should have passion and curiosity about the intersectionality of the basic sciences and therapeutics and be committed to the program requirements and community.

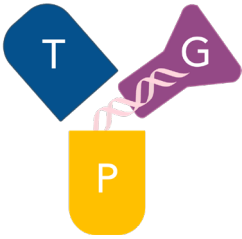

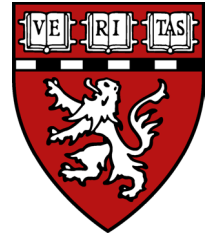
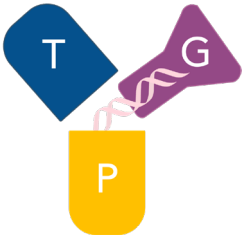
